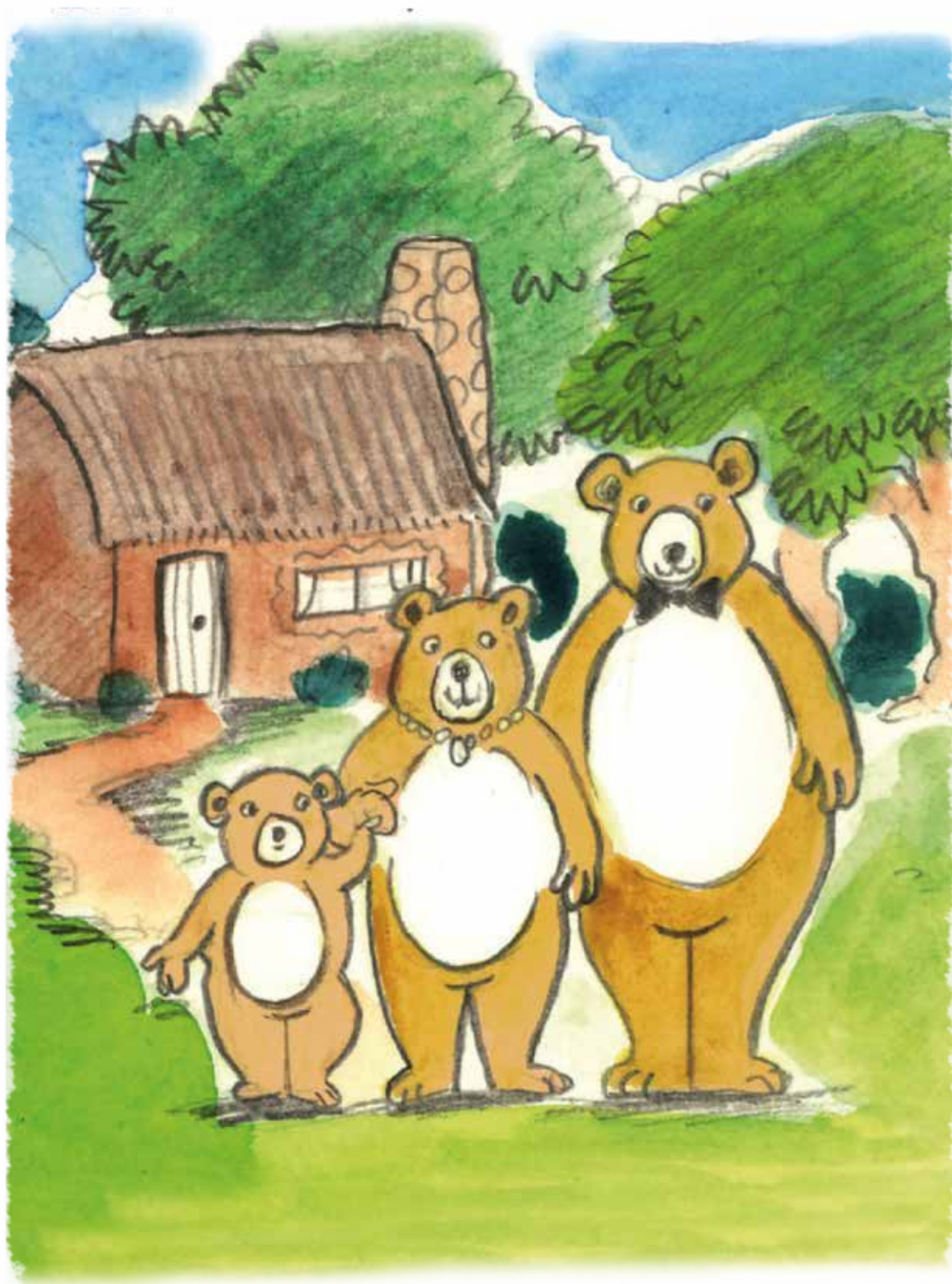


Goldilocks and the three bears

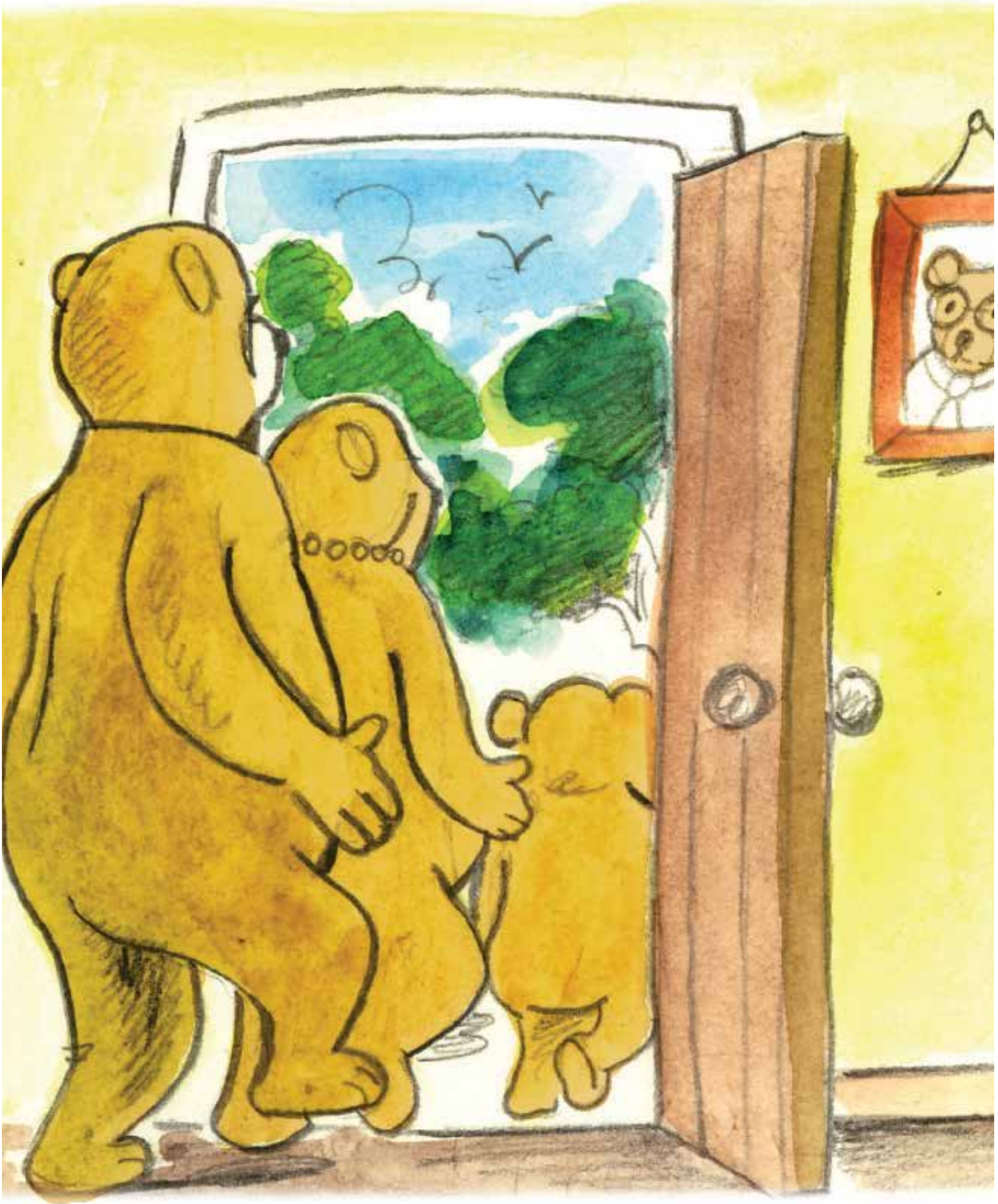

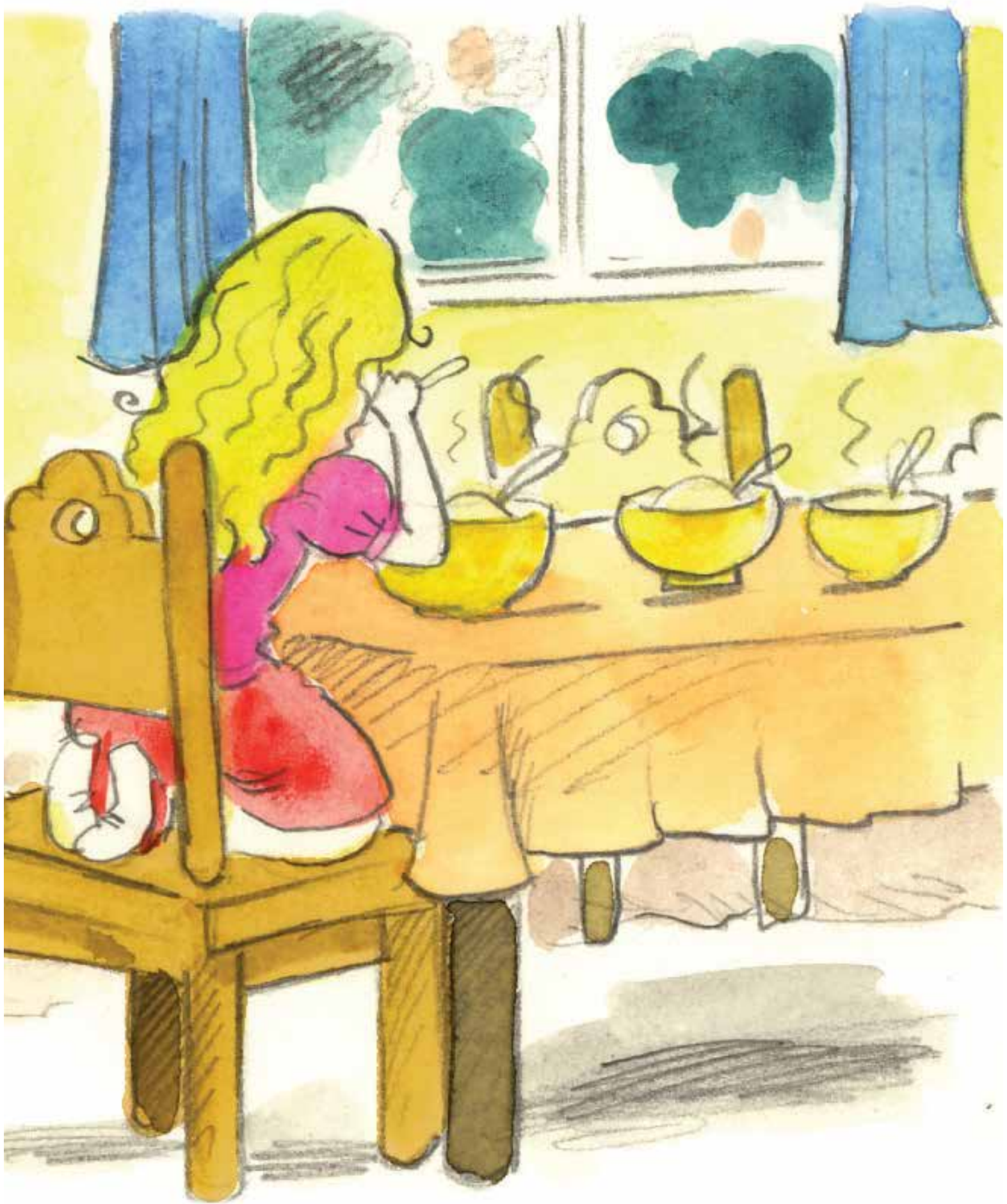
The porridge was too hot.

The three bears came home.



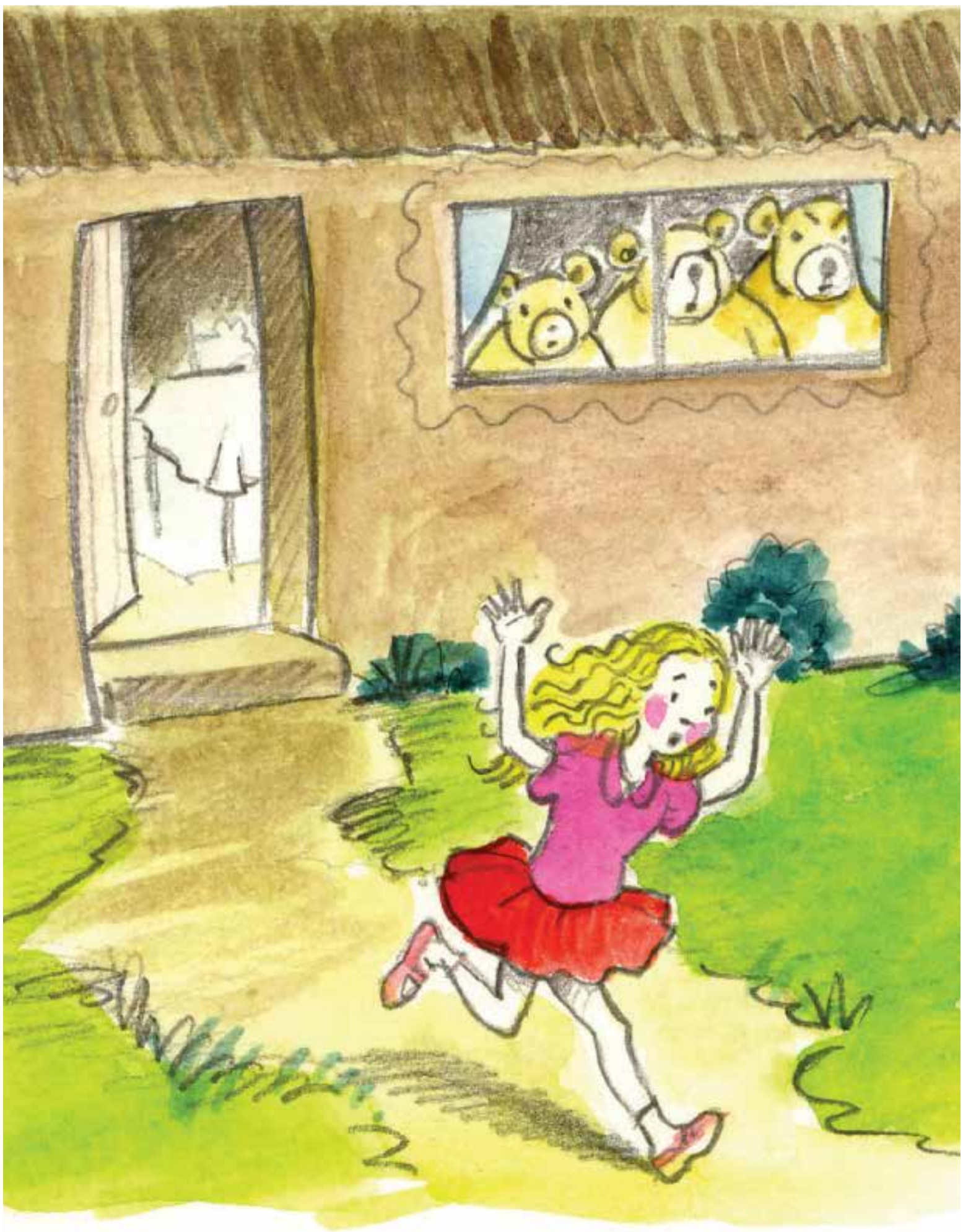
“Who ate my
